The School of Arts & Sciences and Professional Studies

The School of Arts & Sciences and Professional Studies is the academic home for students who wish to commit to a two-year degree pathway that will prepare them to transfer to a four-year university or college and declare a major in a liberal arts or science field. The School of Arts & Sciences and Professional Studies is also the academic home for students who wish to commit to a two-year degree pathway preparing them to work in the following career fields: Business Administration, Information Technology, Early Childhood Education, Criminal Justice, Office Administration, or Medical Office Administration.

The School of Allied Health and CTE (Career & Technical Education)

The School of Allied Health and CTE offers a variety of pathways designed to prepare students to meet the increasing demand for specialized professionals in health care and career technology industries. The School of Allied Health and CTE offers programs at the Associate in Applied Science degree (A.A.S), diploma, and certificate levels. Programs offered include: Automotive Systems Technology, Basic Law Enforcement Training, Cosmetology, Industrial Systems Technology, Welding Technology, Associate Degree Nursing (RN), Practical Nursing (LPN), Dental Hygiene, Human Services Technology, Human Services: Social Services, Phlebotomy, and Nurse Aide: Therapeutic and Diagnostic Services.

Halifax Community College offers the Teacher Preparation Partnership Program in Elementary Education with Elizabeth City State University and the East Carolina University's SECU Partnership East. Also, HCC has a partnership with Chowan University's Adult Degree Completion Program, Eastern Carolina Christian College, American Public University System, Barton College, Bellevue University, Cambridge College, Virginia Union University, North Carolina State University, North Carolina Wesleyan College, University of North Carolina – Greensboro, University of North Carolina – Wilmington, and North Carolina Central University's Nursing and Social Work programs.
