1. You must be a junior or senior.
2. You must have a minimum high school GPA of 2.8 (unweighted).
3. You must meet all course prerequisites.
4. You must demonstrate college readiness on an assessment or placement test. If the student does not have a GPA of 2.8, then the student must demonstrate college readiness in English, reading, and mathematics to be eligible for enrollment.
