## **HCC Reopens for Essential Business Services**

**WELDON, N.C.** – Halifax Community College (HCC) has reopened for essential business services after temporarily suspending services in order to perform a deep cleaning.

HCC temporarily suspended operations on campus for a week as the College sought to deep clean and sanitize the most affected areas of our buildings. Beginning April 14, the campus will reopen for essential business and services only. This means that the Learning Resource Center (LRC) will be open for those students needing access to the computer labs to complete their assignments. However, in keeping with Gov. Roy Cooper’s “shelter-in-place” order of March 27, all employees must still work from home except those performing essential business functions.

Classes will remain online until further notice, as will other services of the College. Students can still contact their instructors and advisors via email or telephone. In addition, registration for the summer and fall semesters began March 30 and is still taking place. Finally, all student support services, counseling, and tutoring services are still available online and via telephone for all students.
