

SACSCOC and Institutional Effectiveness Planning and Assessment (IEPA) Procedure

Justification: The procedure is proposed for the following reasons:

- SACSCOC Accreditation/Reaffirmation is an institutional priority and supersedes the work of any individual or unit
- Compliance with deadlines and accuracy of documents are important in order to comply with the requirements and deadlines of SACSCOC, State, and Federal agencies
- Complacency is not acceptable
- The IE & Advancement unit responsible for accreditation/reaffirmation needs the support and resources to fulfill the task
- Potential loss of institutional accreditation/reaffirmation and the subsequent disruptions in the lives of our students and their parents and the community should be the concerns of all HCC employees

Procedure

In support of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) and the North Carolina General Assembly adopted a provision (S.L.1989; C. 752; S.80), all employees of Halifax Community College (HCC) are required to actively comply with the following:

1. Execute all requirements for the successful SACSCOC accreditation/reaffirmation of HCC
2. Carry out duties/assignments required for SACSCOC accreditation/reaffirmation
3. All employees in all units must comply with the IEPA procedure approved by the President's Council (PC) on October 8, 2019
4. Accurate and current reports and data are required for compliance
5. Compliance with deadlines for the submission of required reports and data
