# QUALIFICATION DEADLINE: ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE RECEIVED FOR PROCESSING NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 7TH, 2025 at 3 pm

\*The process and criteria below apply specifically to the applicant who is already practicing as a licensed practical nurse or a certified paramedic

\*To be eligible to submit a nursing program application, the applicant must first have completed the HCC college admissions application\*

#### A. Halifax Community College Admissions Application

- 6) After you receive your HCC notification of admission, you will need to sign up for new student orientation, complete any required placement testing, and meet with your assigned advisor to plan your courses

## **B. Nursing Program Application Process**

#### 2) Attend the reserved Information Session

- a) Sessions are held in Room B208 in the Health Sciences Building. Sessions begin promptly at 5:30pm. You must attend the entire session in order to receive credit.
- b) Complete the HCC Nursing application form that will be provided to you at the session. A copy of the HCC Nursing application must be submitted to faculty within 24 hours. Instructions for submission will be shared at the information session. Failure to submit the application within 24 hours will result in the applicant having to attend another information session. HCC Nursing applications are not accepted from individuals who have not attended an information session within the previous 12 months.
- c) Submit any additional required documents along with any allied health certifications, licenses, etc. to HCC Admissions Department

NOTE: Students are required to attend an information session in the new application cycle beginning Fall 2025, even if a previous information session was attended. Information sessions will begin promptly at the scheduled time, if you are more than 5 minutes late you will be asked to sign up for another session. ### C. Eligibility

The student's overall grade point average must meet or exceed 2.5 by the end of the semester preceding the application deadline. GPA is determined by the most recent college transcript with a minimum of 12 hours of non-developmental credit.

BIO 168 and 169 are requirements for completion of the program. Priority will be given to the student who has completed BIO 168 and BIO 169 with a letter grade of B or higher. For the advanced placement applicant, it is preferred that BIO 169 have been completed within 5 years of the application deadline.



\*\*Once an applicant has attended an information session and completed a Health Sciences Application, they are then eligible to register for the HESI A2 placement examination.\*\*

After attending an information session, applicants will need to take the HESI admission assessment (A2). Testing will be offered at Halifax Community College from September 2024 through February 2025. Test scores are valid for three years (for example, for the 2025 application year, the HESI A2 test must have been completed no earlier than February 2022). Applications with submissions beyond the deadline will not be considered. Students may take the HESI A2 at HCC up to two times per admission cycle. Please make the testing coordinator aware if you are a second time test taker. **Preference** for testing dates will be given to first time test takers. Test results are accepted from external testing sites provided an official copy of the results are submitted to HCC Admissions prior to the deadline. Students will be required to pay \$60.00 (fees subject to change) with each attempt to take the A2. Fees need to be paid at the HCC Cashier's Office. Please bring a copy of your receipt with you on testing day. Picture ID is required at the testing site. A minimum score of 65% is required for consideration. Students who are repeat testers must notify the testing coordinator prior to sitting for the exam. # **Additional requirements:**

# **Practical Nurse to ADN applicant**

1) Before admission, the Advanced Placement student is encouraged to have taken and received credit for BIO 168, BIO 169, PSY 150, PSY 241, and ENG 111 (other required general education prerequisites may be taken while enrolled in the Nursing Program). Priority will be given to students who have completed these courses. Priority will also be given to students who achieved a B or higher in BIO 168 and BIO 169. It is preferred that BIO 169 have been completed within 5 years of the application deadline. All prerequisites must be completed with a minimum of C.



- 2) Must hold an unencumbered license to practice as an LPN in NC (or Compact license). A copy of the LPN license must be submitted to HCC General Admissions prior to the deadline.
- 3) Applicant must show proof of employment as an LPN who has completed a minimum of 1040 hours within the last year by completing the 1040 hours certification form. (Verification of Hours due by April 30, 2025, at 3pm). See form on page 6.

# Paramedic to ADN

- 1) The Advanced Placement student is encouraged to have taken and received credit for BIO 168, BIO 169, PSY 150, PSY 241, and ENG 111 (other required general education prerequisites may be taken while enrolled in the Nursing Program). Priority will be given to the student who has completed these courses. Priority will be given to the student who has received a B or higher in BIO 168 and BIO 169. It is preferred that BIO 169 have been completed within 5 years of the application deadline. All other prerequisites must be completed with a minimum of C.
- 2) Hold a Paramedic Certification with the North Carolina Office of Emergency Medical Services or National Registry. A copy of the Paramedic certificate must be submitted to HCC General Admissions prior to the deadline.
- 3) Provide evidence of employment of a minimum of 1 year experience as a Paramedic providing direct patient care within the past 2 years. See form below.



# Awarding of Non-course credit upon program admission:

Upon admission to the advanced placement pathway, the student will receive non-course credit for the following courses: NUR 111, 112, 113, and 114.

#### D. Determination of Admission Status

Applicants are ranked and selected for admission based on the following criteria:

- a) GPA
- b) HESI Score
- c) Prerequisite Course Performance
- d) HCC Current Student (enrolled in class)
- e) Halifax or Northampton County Residence
- f) Certifications, Licensures (Allied Health)
- g) Completion of Therapeutics and Diagnostics Pathway

Applicants will be notified of their general admission status by HCC student email within 4-6 weeks of the application deadline.

All additional program correspondence will occur through the student's Halifax Community College email.



# E. Ranking/Conditional Acceptance/Alternate List

- 1. Students should indicate their desired program on their HCC Nursing application.
- 2. Notification of conditional acceptance will be sent by email to the HCC email address of the students who ranked highest in the application process. Notification indicating placement on the alternate list will be sent to all other students who met the ranking qualifications, but were not offered seats in the program at that time (all correspondence will be through HCC email account).
- 3. Students who do not enter the nursing program in Summer 2025 for any reason will need to reapply to be considered for future admission. HCC does not maintain a waiting list. Students may reapply by attending a nursing information session and completing a HCC Nursing application form the following year.

In the event that the ranking process results in the same score for more than one student to be offered a seat, priority will be given first to a student currently attending HCC, then the highest overall GPA.
