ADMISSION PROCEDURE (TRADITIONAL PATHWAY)

QUALIFICATION DEADLINE: ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE RECEIVED FOR PROCESSING NO LATER THAN MARCH 21, 2025 at 3 pm

To be eligible to submit a nursing program application, the applicant must have completed a general admissions application

A. Halifax Community College General Admissions Application

- **You must complete all of the following steps prior to the deadline in addition to the nursing admissions process in order to be considered for admission**
 - 1) Complete Residency Determination at https://ncresidency.cfnc.org/residencyInfo/home
 - 2) Complete the HCC Admissions application to Halifax Community College at https://www.halifaxcc.edu/Admissions/
 - 3) Apply for financial aid at <u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u>
 - a) Use HCC's federal school code: 007986b) If you are a veteran, please see the VA Director in the registrar's office, Building 300, Room 326
 - 4) Submit signed Social Security card to HCC Admissions Department.
 - 5) Submit high school and all post-secondary transcripts required for program admission to HCC Admissions Department, Building 300, Office 312



6) After you receive your HCC notification of admission, you will need to sign up for new student orientation, complete any required placement testing, and meet with your assigned advisor

B. Nursing Program Application Process

Attend the reserved Information Session

- a) Sessions are held in Room B208 in the Health Sciences Building. Sessions begin promptly at 5:30 pm. <u>You must attend the entire session in order to receive credit.</u>
- b) Complete the HCC Nursing application that will be provided to you at the session. A copy of the HCC Nursing application must be submitted to faculty within 24 hours. Instructions for submission will be shared at the information session. A delay in submitting the HCC Nursing application will result in the applicant having to attend an additional information



session. HCC Nursing applications are not accepted from individuals who have not attended an information session within the previous 12 months.

c) Submit additional required documents along with any allied health certifications, licenses, etc. to HCC Admissions Department

NOTE: Students are required to attend an information session in the new application cycle beginning Fall 2025, even if a previous information session was attended. Information sessions will begin promptly at the scheduled time, if you are more than 5 minutes late you will be asked to sign up for another session. C. Eligibility

The student's overall grade point average must meet or exceed 2.5 by the end of the semester preceding the application deadline. GPA is determined by the most recent college transcript with a minimum of 12 hours of non-developmental credit. If a student has no transcript with 12 or more credit hours, then high school GPA is used to determine eligibility.

BIO 168 and 169 are requirements for completion of the nursing program. Priority will be given to the student who has completed BIO 168 and BIO 169 with a letter grade of B or higher. It is preferred that the student have completed BIO 169 within 3 years of the application deadline.

Once an applicant has attended an information session and completed a Health Sciences Application, they are then eligible to register for the HESI A2 placement examination.

After attending an information session, applicants will need to take the HESI admission assessment (A2). Testing will be offered at Halifax Community College from September 2024 through February 2025. **Test scores are valid for three years (for example, for the 2025 application year, the HESI test must have been completed no earlier than March 2022)**. Applications with submissions beyond the deadline will not be considered. Students may take the HESI at HCC a maximum of two times per admission cycle. Please make the testing coordinator aware if you are a second time test taker. **Preference for testing dates will be given to first time test takers.** Test results are accepted from



external testing sites provided an official copy of the results are submitted to HCC Admissions prior to the deadline. Arranging to test at an alternate site is the responsibility of the student. Students will be required to pay \$60.00 (fees subject to change) with each attempt to take the A2. Fees need to be paid at the HCC Cashier's Office. Please bring a copy of your receipt with you on testing day. Picture ID is required at the testing site. A minimum score of 65% is required for consideration. Students who are repeat testers must notify the testing coordinator prior to sitting for the exam.

D. Determination of Admission Status

Applicants are ranked and selected for admission based on the following criteria:

- a) GPA
- b) HESI Score
- c) Prerequisite Course Performance
- d) HCC Current Student (enrolled in class)
- e) Halifax or Northampton County Residence
- f) Certifications, Licensures (Allied Health)
- g) Completion of Therapeutics and Diagnostics Pathway

Applicants will be notified of their general admission status by HCC student email within 4-6 weeks of the application deadline.

All additional program correspondence will occur through the Halifax Community College student email.



D. Ranking/Conditional Acceptance/Alternate List

- 1. Student's should indicate desired program on their HCC Nursing application
- 2. Notification of conditional acceptance will be sent by email to the HCC email address of the students who ranked highest in the application process. Notification indicating placement on the alternate list will be sent to all other students who met the ranking qualifications, but were not offered seats in the program at that time (all correspondence will be through HCC email account).
- 3. Students who do not enter the nursing program in Fall 2025 for any reason will need to reapply to be considered for future admission. HCC does not maintain a waiting list. Students may reapply by attending a nursing information session and completing an HCC Nursing application form the following year.

In the event that the ranking process results in the same score for more than one student to be offered a seat, priority will be given first to a student currently attending HCC, then the highest overall GPA.

- Priority is given to those with a program-specific GPA of 2.5 or higher if the student has completed general education courses for the program.
- A grade of "C" or better is required in all courses. It is preferred that BIO 168 and BIO 169 have been completed within the prior 3 years. Priority will be given to students who have achieved a B or higher in BIO 168 and BIO 169.
- GPA is determined by the most recent college transcript with a minimum of 12 hours of non-developmental credit.
